OVERVIEW

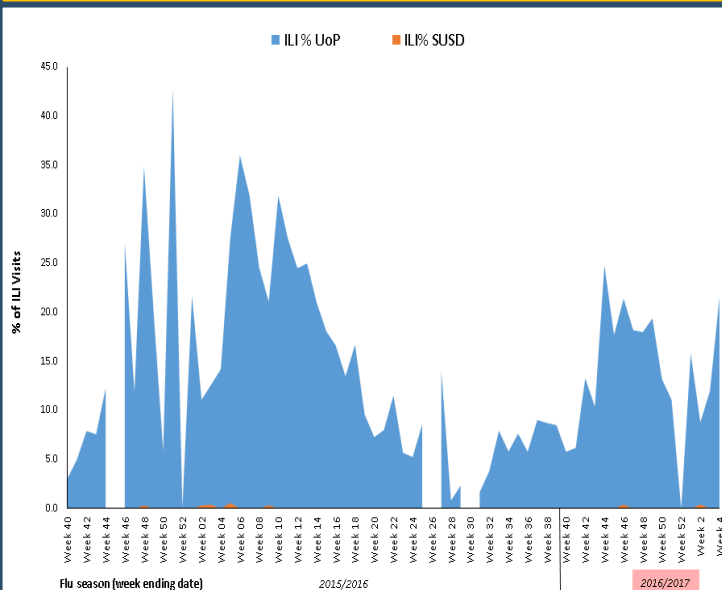
- Surveillance indicators show influenza is active throughout the county.
- Influenza A (H3) is predominantly circulating at this time.

Severe influenza cases (ages <65 yrs)	8	12
Intensive Care Unit (ICU) admissions due to influenza (ages <65 yrs)	5	8
Deaths due to influenza (ages <65 yrs)	3	4
Deaths due to Respiratory Syncytial Virus (RSV) (ages <5 yrs)	0	1
Respiratory outbreaks	1	3

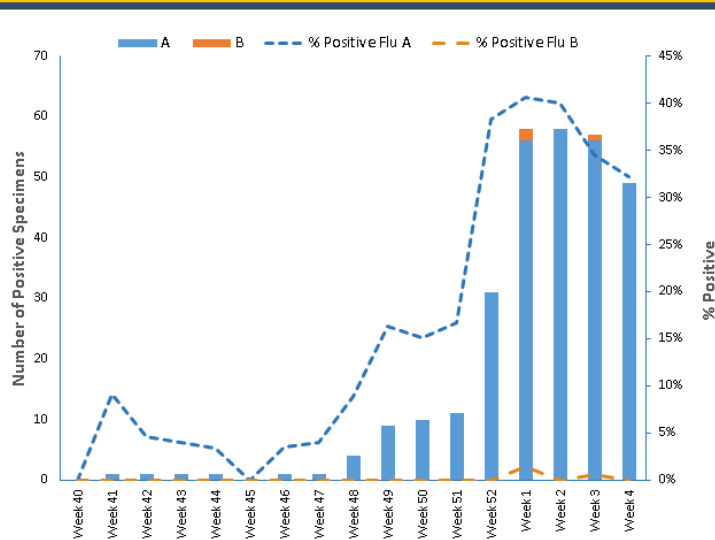
Influenza-like Illness (ILI) Visits

University of Pacific (UoP) and Stockton Unified School District (SUSD)



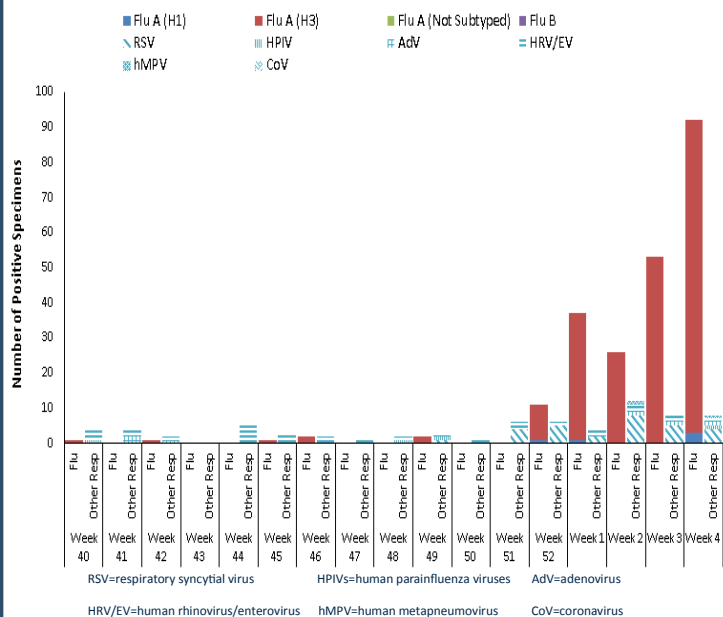
Influenza Positive Tests
