

San Joaquin County Respiratory Illness Report


September 30, 2018 (Week 40) — January 12, 2019 (Week 2)

OVERVIEW

🥠 The overall percentage of influenza detections in sentinel clinical laboratories is starting to increase in January (Figure 1).

🥠 Three confirmed deaths (all ages) this flu season compared to eleven during the same time period last flu season (Table 1).

🥠 The majority of influenza positive specimens this season are Influenza A/H1N1(Figure 2) - a component of this year's vaccine.
