

## OVERVIEW

🥠 This season continues to be milder than the 2017-2018 season (Table 1 & Figure 1).

🥠 Five confirmed deaths (all ages) this flu season compared to sixteen during the same time period last flu season (Table 1).

🐠 The majority of influenza positive specimens this season are Influenza A/H1N1(Figure 2) - a component of this year's vaccine.
