





San Joaquin County Respiratory Illness Report

September 30, 2018 (Week 40) — February 9, 2019 (Week 6)

OVERVIEW

- This season continues to be milder than the 2017-2018 season (Table 1 & Figure 1).
- Six confirmed deaths (all ages) this flu season compared to nineteen during the same time period last flu season (Table 1).
- The majority of influenza positive specimens this season are Influenza A/H1N1(Figure 2) a component of this year's vaccine.
