





San Joaquin County Respiratory Illness Report

September 30, 2018 (Week 40) — March 2, 2019 (Week 9)

OVERVIEW

- This season overall continues to be milder than the 2017-2018 season even though the % positive is currently higher (Table 1 & Figure 1).
- 🎍 Nine confirmed deaths (all ages) this flu season compared to twenty-three during the same time period last flu season (Table 1).
- 🅠 In Week 9, the majority of influenza positive specimens were A/H3N2 instead of A/H1N1 (Figure 2).
