

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Case and Death—Details

Disclaimers:

- "New Cases" and "New Deaths" counts are cases/deaths that have been reported since the previous update.
 - Some weeks may have negative values (highlighted in blue) due to data cleaning efforts. Positive values will be highlighted in yellow.
- Data are preliminary and subject to change as information is verified.

Definitions:

- Cases:
 - <u>Confirmed</u>: Detection of SARS-CoV-2 RNA in a clinical specimen (swab) using a molecular amplification detection test (PCR).
 - A patient is counted only once if they have multiple positive tests.
 - <u>Not Counted:</u> Antigen or antibody tests.
- Deaths:
 - COVID-19 is listed as the leading cause of death or significant condition on the death certificate as per CDPH's definition. May be removed from the total once the final ICD-10 code is received.
 - There is a substantial delay in receiving notification of deaths. Totals by week will change as PHS receives information.


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Deaths by Comorbidities



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Outbreak—Details

Disclaimers:

- "New Outbreaks" are outbreaks that have been reported since the previous update.
- Data are preliminary and subject to change as information is verified.

Definitions:

(per CDPH guidelines, updated Dec 2020)

- <u>Acute Care Hospitals</u>: At least two lab confirmed COVID-19 in patients 7 days after admission for a non-COVID condition or healthcare providers that (a) do not share households, (b) are not contacts to one another outside the facility.
- Long-Term Care Facilities: At least one lab confirmed COVID-19 in a resident, that was acquired in the facility.
- <u>Residential Congregate Settings (non-healthcare)</u>: At least three probable or confirmed cases (residents and/ or employees) within two weeks, that was acquired in the setting.
 - Examples include: dormitories, group homes, jails, prisons, shelters.
- <u>Non-Residential Congregate Settings (non-healthcare)</u>: At least three probable or confirmed cases within two weeks with a common source and are from different households.
 - Examples include: workplaces, childcare facilities, schools, weddings, churches.


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Outbreaks by Industry


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Variant Cases by Specimen Collection Date



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Vaccination—Details

Disclaimers:

- This information may not match other state websites due to differences in when the data was pulled, and the data sources used.
- Population estimates are for individuals 12 years and older.
- The reporting of vaccine administration data into the immunization registries is consistently an under-count of actual number of doses administered locally, due to incomplete and delayed reporting into these systems.
- Providers that receive the vaccine are responsible for entering information into an immunization registry (Healthy Futures or CAIR2).
- Vaccine administration data is extracted from these registries. Administered doses are not counted if there is uncertainty regarding the county of residence. If the patient's address is missing, their administration site (i.e., Dameron) will be used as a proxy.
- May not include the following vaccinations of San Joaquin Residents:
 - Individuals vaccinated but are not reported in Healthy Futures or CAIR2.
 - Individuals vaccinated at Federal facilities (VA, Prisons, Skilled Nursing Facilities).
