



ORDER OF THE SAN JOAQUIN COUNTY PUBLIC HEALTH OFFICER

RE: COVID-19 LIMITATIONS ON HOSPITAL VISITORS

On March 15, 2020 an order was issued by the San Joaquin County Public Health Officer directing the staff at all Hospitals to exclude from entry or access any Visitors and Non-Essential Personnel, including visitors to patients at the Hospital. This order was issued to slow the spread of the virus, protect the ability of the public and private health care providers to handle the influx of patients, and safeguard public health and safety.

UNDER THE AUTHORITY OF CALIFORNIA HEALTH AND SAFETY CODE SECTIONS 101040, 101085, AND 120175, THE HEALTH OFFICER OF THE COUNTY OF SAN JOAQUIN ORDERS:

Effective 8:00 a.m. on October 13, 2020, the Order of March 15, 2020 imposing limitations on hospital visitors is rescinded
