There is no such thing as a safe street drug. Know the risks.

Fentanyl is often **ADDED** to other illegal drugs without people knowing.

Fentanyl has been found in:

- Heroin
- Meth
- Fake pills—Oxycodone, Norco, Xanax
- Cocaine



50-100 times

Heroin • Oxycodone • Morphine

#### Fen•ta•nyl

Prescription opioid narcotic, intended for cancer patients in severe pain

Can be absorbed through the skin

You can't see it, smell it, or taste it.

### Warning signs of

## **Fentanyl Overdose**

- Discolored skin: blueish-purple for light-skin people; greyish for darker-skin people
- Snoring, gasping, or gurgling sounds known as "death rattle"
- Extreme muscle rigidity, to point of seizures





- Foaming at the mouth
- → Blood from nose and mouth
- → Weak, barely-detectable pulse



### If You Use Substances:



#### **Have Naloxone**

Overdose happens fast. Make sure you and your friends carry Naloxone / Narcan.



#### Don't use alone

Make sure someone is around, to give Naloxone / Narcan if you overdose.
